SIUC SUCCESS Program for VETERANS

Funded by Illinois Department of Veterans Affairs & SIUC

The SUCCESS Program at Southern Illinois University Carbondale is funded by the IDVA and SIUC to provide Veterans with targeted services to ensure the academic success and well being of students after honorable discharge from military service. All of these services are currently available to Veterans and other students, but require fees per visit. These charges will be covered by the SUCCESS Program to qualified Veterans until funding ends. The services covered by SUCCESS Program funding may include the following:

Student Health Center

- Medical Visit fees
- Dental Care fees
- Physical Therapy Visit fees & Video Conferencing
- Wellness Center fees
 - Alcohol/Drug counseling
 - Stress Management counseling & Biofeedback relaxation training
 - Nutrition counseling
 - Sexuality Issues counseling (HIV testing/STI testing)

Counseling Center

- Counseling
- Psycho educational and other diagnostic testing

Other services provided through the IDVA funding includes:

- Tutorial software for supplemental instruction in Math, Composition, Sciences and other subjects as needed
- Disability Support Services

Recreation Center

- Free memberships for non-student Veterans (limited amounts/selection process to be announced)
- Specialized equipment for Veterans with disabilities

These services will help to assist Veterans with a full range of services at SIUC as we attempt to show appreciation to our returning warriors for their service to our country.
